The Position

The Director of Student Activities is responsible for providing leadership and oversight for student leadership development, traditions, programming groups, the Outdoor Adventure Program, community service, Greek Life and student organizations. The Director plays a pivotal role and works closely with students to initiate, plan, develop, and facilitate events and activities to enhance the quality of student life and University experience for all students.

- Lead the departmental budgeting processes; make fiscally responsible decisions and recommendations.
- Evaluate, revise, and maintain student activities policies and procedures.
- Advise the Undergraduate Student Government.
- Coordinate the allocation processes for a portion of the Student Activity Fee.

- Work irregular hours at certain times to the nature of the position.

Position Requirements

- Master's degree in student personnel or a related field, or the equivalent combination of education, training and experience from which comparable skills can be acquired.
- Three years of professional experience at a college or university in student activities and/or closely related field.
- Demonstrated capability in leading, managing and motivating staff.
- Demonstrated ability to plan, organize, and execute complex events.
- Experience advising student organizations/groups.
- Excellent leadership, organization, interpersonal, and oral/written/presentations skills.
- Demonstrated teambuilding and networking skills.
- Evidence of commitment to enhancement of diversity.
- Demonstrated ability to build relationships and collaborate with faculty, students, parents, staff, and advisors.
- Demonstrated ability and willingness to work evening and weekend hours.
- Experience using personal computers including word processing and spreadsheet/database software.
- Proven competence in managing multiple tasks and competing priorities.
- Ability to operate a motor vehicle.
