Dean of the College of Engineering

Michigan Technological University invites inquiries, applications, and nominations for the position of Dean of the College of Engineering (COE). The Dean of Engineering is the chief academic and administrative officer for the COE and reports directly to the Provost. The Dean is responsible for strategic planning, development, and administration of the College, as well as managing relationships with other University units and outside educational institutions, alumni, government, and the private sector. The Dean will be central in realizing the University's vision to grow as a premier research university and become a top 50 public university. The University is entering its fifth year of a strategic faculty hiring initiative, which has hired 18 new faculty campus-wide. See <http://www.mtu.edu/sfhi> for more details.

Michigan Tech enrolls over 7000 students of which 3950 are in the COE, including 720 engineering graduate students. The COE has 10 ABET accredited undergraduate programs and masters and doctoral programs in 11 disciplines. The College comprises eight departments with 140 faculty members. US News & World Report ranks four Michigan Tech graduate engineering programs among the best in the country. ASEE ranks Michigan Tech as the 19th school in the nation in engineering bachelor's degrees awarded, with about 20% going to women. COE external research expenditures exceeded \$13 million in 2010.
