
Professional Development in International Business (PDIB)

Program Overview

Florida International University CIBER is pleased to announce the Fourth Annual 2012 Professional Development in International Business (PDIB) India. This PDIB is designed for professionals and faculty interested in pursuing their interests in the Indian business environment. Participants will experience firsthand how multinationals and leading Indian companies are riding the downfall, while simultaneously reshaping the Indian business environment resulting in a competitive India.

The program will take place in Bangalore and Mumbai, two of the most advanced and business forward cities throughout India.
