**LUFP is offering seven unpaid urban farmer internships for summer 2014.** Interns work with farm staff to plant, weed, tend, and harvest crops. They also help prepare for markets, participate in community outreach, and complete other farm tasks and projects.

**Qualified applicants** will have strong communication skills, a desire to work as part of a farm team, willingness to work outdoors in all weather conditions and the ability to perform a diverse set of farm tasks that includes lifting and carrying heavy objects (as much as 40 lbs at times).

**Schedule:** One day/week internships run from May 7th-August 22<sup>nd</sup> either on Wednesdays 8am-noon or Thursdays 8am-noon. Monthly internships are Tuesdays-Fridays 8am-noon for one month in either May, June, July, or August. Specify availability in cover letter.
