CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

You are invited to submit abstracts to the AIB-ANZ Chapter Annual Symposium, to be held on Friday, 14th November 2014, at Cliftons Conference Centre, Sydney. New this year, a paper development workshop (PDW) will be held on the previous day, Thursday, 13th November 2014, from 1pm to 5pm.

This annual event has established itself as a valuable opportunity for obtaining collegial feedback on ongoing research. It provides a forum for developing future journal articles and research volume publications, as well as networking with other researchers working in the area of international business.

The theme of this year's symposium is 'Changing and Leading International Business: A Cross-Disciplinary Perspective'. This year's symposium will explore the opportunities and implications of the interdisciplinary nature of international business research. Abstracts on other topics relevant to the field, as well as topics relating to teaching international business subjects, including international aspects of marketing, human resource management, organisational behaviour, strategic management, and finance, among others, are also welcome. All accepted abstracts will be published online with an ISBN.

For the PDW, we invite submissions of research/conceptual/viewpoint papers on a range of aspects of international business. Papers accepted for the PDW will be presented and discussed in small-group workshops led by senior academics, who will provide authors with constructive feedback to help develop the papers for submission to top-tier journals. We strongly encourage early career academics, including PhD students, to make use of this opportunity.

Submissions – one-page abstracts of up to 750 words for the symposium (Friday) and papers of up to 25 pages for the PDW (Thursday) – should be emailed to Dr Ramudu Bhanugopan (<u>bramudu@csu.edu.au</u>), with the following in the subject of the email: AIB-ANZ Symposium & <your surname>.
