

Having reached its 28th edition, the Sinergie Italian Journal of Management Annual Conference is a well-established scientific meeting that brings together scholars from the field of management to present and discuss their research in a collaborative and friendly environment.

- 9) From the handicraft to ownerless productions, such as FabLab, digital makers, 3D, ...
- 10) Firm size and digitisation in manufacturing and services processes
- 11) Digital world and extended logistics networks
- 12) Social media and consumer relations: experiences and sharing value
- 13) 'Internet of things' and consumer knowledge
- 14) Augmented reality and new media
- 15) Production of value in the digital world and territorial infrastructures
- 16) Higher education in the digital world: a disruptive perspective

Publication Opportunities

All paper submissions will be double-blind reviewed and a proceedings volume with ISBN and DOI will be published. The open-access *Conference Proceedings* will be released on the Sinergie web portal (www.eng.sinergiejournal.it) after the conference.

<u>Full papers or extended abstracts may be submitted</u>. In addition to the ordinary paper sessions, we are planning to organise one or more 'paper-development sessions' in which attendants can present working papers or extended abstracts and benefit from comments and suggestions from the chairpersons and other participants through a constructive and interactive discussion.

The official languages of the conference are English and Italian.

Authors may choose to publish either full papers or extended abstracts in the *Conference Proceedings*. A selection of the papers by the scientific committee will be included in a 2016 *Sinergie Italian Journal of Management* special issue.
