

Postdoctoral Associate in Graduate Training and Development. Graduate School, New Brunswick, Rutgers University

The Graduate School-New Brunswick of Rutgers University is seeking applications for a full-time Postdoctoral Associate to work with administrators and faculty to develop, coordinate, oversee and assess new and innovative programs and activities in areas of graduate student professional development. We define graduate student professional development broadly, as a cross-disciplinary effort that includes activities (courses; workshops; hands-on training; outreach) in areas such as communication and mentoring that are essential for students to succeed in graduate school and careers. The selected individual will be expected to work with faculty across disciplines, as well as relevant administrators, to (a) devise and implement innovative and effective activities that are widely available to the graduate student community, led by qualified individuals in and outside the university, and targeted to address the cross-cutting learning goals of a diverse graduate student population; (b) develop, carry out and analyze appropriate assessments and evaluations of the activities; (c) participate in disseminating and publishing relevant results, as well as in efforts to seek and obtain external funding to expand the efforts. Appointments will be for duration of 1 year beginning July, 2016, with option to renew.

Job Requirements

A Ph.D., or equivalent, in the areas in or related to education, higher education, or policy.
A record of publication in education, higher education, learning science, educational policy, and/or higher education assessments.
Training or equivalent experience in design and use of assessment and evaluation tools.
Excellent communication skills.
Teaching experience at undergraduate or graduate levels and prior postdoctoral research experience are desirable.
