



Post-doctoral Position in Finance/Economics **Gustavson School of Business, University of Victoria, Canada.**

The Gustavson School of Business, University of Victoria, Canada, invites applications for a full time position of Post-doctoral Fellow in Finance/Economics.

The successful candidate will be working on an SSHRC-funded research project on financial systems and macro-financial stability primarily with Professor Basma Majerbi, in collaboration with other researchers at McGill University, HEC Montreal, University of Geneva and the International Monetary Fund.

Applicants should hold a PhD in finance or economics or be very close to receiving their PhD by the starting date of the Post-doctoral Fellowship. They should demonstrate strong potential in conducting research related to financial markets and institutions. Candidates should also demonstrate strong background in empirical research methods in financial economics and be familiar with advanced statistical software. Data management skills are an asset. Full proficiency in English is required.

As part of the duties of the post-doctoral fellow, the successful candidate is expected to actively participate in the research design, data collection, empirical testing, and assist with other project-related tasks (supervising research assistants, coordinate meetings with partners, etc.). She/He will have opportunities to contribute to publishing research results in peer-reviewed international journals as well as present research findings in leading refereed conferences. No teaching requirement is associated with this position. However, candidates who wish to build up their teaching experience may be allowed to teach a course.

In line with immigration requirements, preference will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents, but applications from international candidates are strongly encouraged. The starting date of the Post-doctoral Fellowship is July 1, 2017 (negotiable). The appointment is for 12 months, renewable to a total of 24 months depending on performance.
