- Have the ability to identify species of aquatic plants, choose herbicides to target growth and apply appropriate treatments.
- Field experience in water quality monitoring. Independently conduct manual collection of lake and pond water quality data such as temperature, pH, DO, etc. Record and report findings. (preferred, but can train)
- Be familiar with and be able to comply with state and federal regulations pertaining to Aquatic Nuisance Control, specifically Natural Resources and EPA Act. 451, part 33.
- Keep track of and file required application treatment reports, internal and MDEQ.

- Ability to read and interpret herbicide labels, operating procedures, and safety rules
- Able and willing to work in various/extreme weather conditions (8+ hrs. per day). Candidate
 must be comfortable performing assigned duties outdoors while walking through various and
 challenging terrain, including but not limited to water, heavy vegetation and uneven land.
