


The Michigan DNR hires seasonal Outreach Guides to work in 5 parks in southeast Michigan. You'll have the opportunity to connect urban youth to nature by teaching outdoor skills and activities to organized youth groups. Programs include archery, fishing, camping, & nature studies.



We offer training in hands-on environmental activities, marketing & presentation skills. Program supplies are provided. Need an internship? Positions may be adapted to fulfill your specific requirements.



Positions are 40 hours/week and pay is \$9.45/hour. Housing is NOT provided and you should be willing to work Monday-Friday and provide your own transportation to assigned park locations.



Work begins with training in mid-May and continues through the summer until mid-August.
