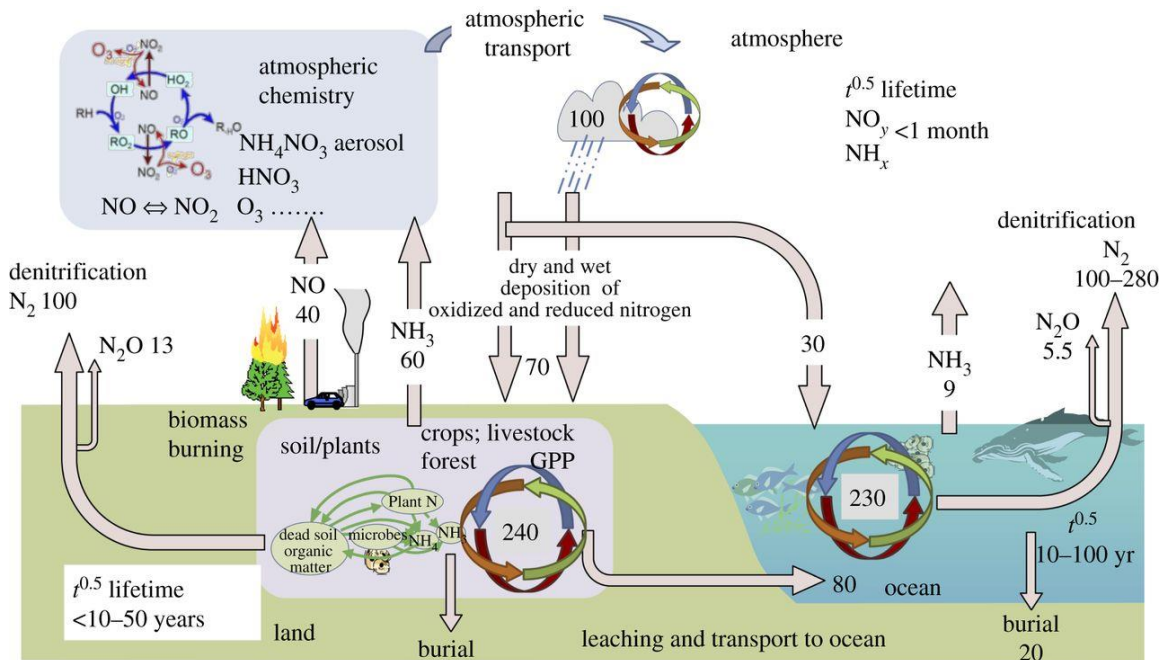


# Biogeochemistry
