The primary role of this job will be to provide support to our Investigation & Remediation group. This group routinely investigates contaminant releases and formulates remedial strategies to achieve regulatory closure. The candidate will also be trained in additional services provided by our other service groups (such as Environmental Due Diligence and Hazardous Materials Assessments).

Responsibilities:

- Provide assistance on contaminant investigation and remediation projects, primarily regulated under Part 201 (Environmental Remediation) and 213 (Leaking Underground Storage Tanks) of Public Act 451
- Conduct field work, including oversight of soil borings, installation of monitoring wells, monitoring well elevational surveys, slug tests, remedial actions, and sampling activities for soil, groundwater, soil-gas, and surface water
- Provide general environmental support to project managers and clients, including on-site assistance, as needed
- Compile and evaluate data for technical reporting and/or further evaluation
- Perform quality assurance/quality control on aspects of technical reports (tables/analytical, figures, etc.)
- Perform project tasks within scope/budget/schedule expectations and ensure quality standards on project deliverables
- Support Triterra project managers in delivering exceptional client value on projects
