Remote Internships

Remote internships are an opportunity to contribute to the **conservation of fragile species** and understudied ecosystems in Paraguay through independent research projects. PLT provides interns with access to more than **10 years of ecological data** to write an academic report or a dissertation thesis, and ultimately a publishable article! PLT's staff act as supervisors, providing their guidance and expertise.





PLT has already co-created custom internships for several universities, including the University of Belfast (UK) and Northeastern University (US).

Internship topics include:

- Bird diversity
- Primate behavior
- Bat distribution
- Reptile behavior
- Conservation Policy
- Environmental Education

Online Courses

Para La Tierra offers in-depth online courses with video lectures and relevant scientific literature, giving a broad understanding of the topic. All courses have **one-on-one mentorship with experts**.

Primatology Online Course: created by our Primatologist and Country Director and designed to be a guide on world-wide primatology science and conservation. It includes 30h of video lectures, suggested reading materials, course evaluations and access to the student forum. Already 54 students enrolled!





Sustainable Communities & Environmental Change in Latin America: an interdisciplinary social science and humanities field school aimed at both university students and life-learners alike. This certificate course offers seminars and virtual field-trips with field experts across Latin America. It was created in collaboration with 5 NGOs based in Latin America. Registrations are now open for the February session.

You can choose to participate in **scientific field studies** or collaborate with the **environmental education** program; gaining professional experience in either field.

Depending on your level of experience, you can join the program as a **volunteer** or as an **intern**.

Unique habitats

Para La Tierra conducts its research across three habitats:

- Neembucu wetlands: an area of 8000km² surrounding the city of Pilar
- **Upper Paraná Atlantic forest:** subtropical semi-deciduous forest
- **Dry Chaco:** largest dry forest in South America
