NATURE OF ASSIGNMENT: As per Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act and Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, the Regulatory Office carries out the Corps' Regulatory mission to protect the nation's aquatic resources and navigational capacity, while allowing reasonable development through fair, flexible, and balanced permit decisions. The primary duties for this position include: evaluating applications for permits and modification of permits for activities or work in waters of the United States; performing field site reviews and preparing site evaluations to determine jurisdiction, establish base environmental conditions, and characterize the biological, physical, cultural/social attributes on project sites. Duties require: communication with applicants/permittees, agents/consultants, the general public, and local/ State/Federal government agencies; analysis of public interest factors supporting permit issuance, modification, or denial; and preparation/management of technical documentation supporting permit decisions.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: In order to qualify for this position, you must meet the minimum education requirements for the Biologist occupational series number GS-0401. You will be required to provide official transcripts and resume upon selection.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT: US Citizenship is required.
