POSITION: Fisheries Aide – Spring through Fall 2023

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT: This is a temporary position. Dates of employment are not fixed but will start around when the ice goes out on inland waters, and end in late October.

SUPERVISION: Reports to GLIFWC Inland Fisheries Biologist or designee.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES: Assist with fish surveys in ceded territory lakes and rivers. Will include a variety of survey methods with some nighttime work. Participate in summer habitat surveys on walleye waters. Work with GLIFWC staff and partners on research projects likely to include a fish movements in Mille Lacs Lake and post-release stress response of angled walleye in Wisconsin. Persons will help launch and operate boats, catch fish using electrofishing, netting, and angling gear, and collect biological information. Ability to travel for up to 3 consecutive weeks in the spring and fall is preferred but not required. Overnight lodging, per diem, and mileage will be paid. Must be willing to share overnight lodging accommodations with co-workers.

QUALIFICATIONS: Ability to identify gamefish and panfish.
