

WAIB Emerging Scholar Award 2023

Purpose: The WAIB Emerging Scholar Award goes to a junior female scholar for recognition of her high-quality research in any international business discipline. Preference may be given to high-quality research on gender in particular; but this is not a requirement. Application is by nomination only.

Criteria: To qualify for the award, the nominee must be a WAIB member (please check and update AIB profile) who identifies as female and is either a current doctoral student or have received her Ph.D. in 2018 or later*. Neither paper acceptance nor physical presence at the upcoming AIB Annual Meeting is required.

Process: To be considered, nominations must include a 1-page single-spaced statement of why the nominee deserves to win the award, including the nominee's affiliation, email address, and a list of her publications and scholarly work.

Submissions must be sent as an attachment to waib@aib.world using the subject heading "WAIB Emerging Scholar Award" by May 15, 2022. WAIB Board members will evaluate nominations and announce the winner at the upcoming AIB Annual Meeting and through all WAIB electronic communications: WAIB-L listserv, Facebook, and LinkedIn. The winner will also receive a paper certificate suitable for framing (in person at the annual meeting, or via email).

^{*}The WAIB Board might consider applicants who graduated earlier than 2018 if they paused their careers for the birth or adoption of a child or other external circumstances on a case-by-case basis.
