AS A TREK DIRECTOR ASSISTANT, YOU WILL BE TRAINED AND EXPECTED TO AID SCOUTS IN PREPARING FOR THEIR 5-DAY TREK IN THE BOB MARSHALL WILDERNESS. THIS PROGRAM IS SCOUT-LED AND ENCOURAGES SCOUTS TO CREATE THEIR OWN ITINERARY AND UTILIZE THEIR LEADERSHIP SKILLS TO EXECUTE IT. OUR TREK ASSISTANTS WILL ENSURE SAFETY BOTH ON TRAIL AND IN THE WATER, TEACH BACKCOUNTRY SKILLS AND PROMOTE LEAVE NO TRACE PRINCIPLES WITH EACH CREW THAT ATTEND MOHAB. THE SHORT, ROUGHLY 6-WEEK SEASON, OF THE POSITION MAKES IT A FAST-PACED ONE WITH LOTS OF TIME SPENT IN THE BACKCOUNTRY SO COME PREPARED WITH AN OPEN MIND AND A POSITIVE ATTITUDE!
